### **OUR IMPACT**

#### TB PROGRAM IN 3 DISTRICTS

**Goal**: The project focused on enhancement of village midwives to increase Tuberculosis Preventive Treatment (TPT) coverage. Collaboration with District Government, District Health Office and Puskesmas.









214 village midwives trained

407 contacts TB screened

260 TST tested

25 initiated TPT treatment.

## INTEGRATED HEALTH EDUCATION IN HIBALA - NIAS SELATAN DISTRICT

To ensure the children will get nutritious food at home then the mothers were trained on how to do organic vegetables gardening. Mothers learned how to prepare and cooked healthy food and snack for their children by using what available in the areas.
