## TB PROGRAM IN 3 DISTRICTS

**Goal:** The project focused on enhancement of village midwives to increase Tuberculosis Preventive Treatment (TPT) coverage. Collaboration with District Government, District Health Office and Puskesmas.

Tuberculosis Preventive Treatment program implemented in 3 districts in Sumatera Utara province with 5 main interventions. Capacity building of village midwife in doing screening, identify TB contact and presumptive cases to refer to Puskesmas for Latent TB infection testing and treatment, capacity building for Puskemas TB workers on standard testing and treatment for Latent TB Infection, upgrade Puskesmas laboratory equipment and supplies for testing TB and Latent TB Infection, health education for the community through meetings and seminars to improve the awareness and facilitating stakeholders meeting and advocacy for quality and sustainable Tuberculosis Preventive Treatment services.

## PRIMARY HEALTH SERVICES FROM ISLAND TO ISLAND IN NIAS SELATAN

Through collaboration with local government, the mobile clinic provided services to the people in the remote areas and educate the community
